TITLE: GRANT APPLICATION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON SUPPORTING AND AUTHORIZING THE BARBERTON FIRE DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT A GRANT REQUEST TO THE TUSCORA HEALTH AND WELLNESS FOUNDATION, FOR THE PURCHASE OF SEVEN AED'S FOR USE IN FIRE DEPARTMENT APPARATUS AND AUXILIARY VEHICLES, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$14,629.72, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this grant will replace four AED's that are over 15 years old and are no longer serviceable; and

WHEREAS, this grant will add an AED to three trucks that currently do not have one.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Barberton supports and authorizes the Barberton Fire Department to apply to the Tuscora Health and Wellness Foundation, for the purchase of seven AED's for use in Fire Department apparatus and auxiliary vehicles, in the amount of Fourteen Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars and Seventy-Two Cents (\$14,629.72).

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to move forward in a timely manner, and pre-construction coordination, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
