ORDINANCE NO. 147-2025

**TITLE: LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT
NCL GOVERNMENT CAPITAL**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A LEASE TO PURCHASE AN AGREEMENT WITH NCL GOVERNMENT CAPITAL ON BEHALF OF SOUTHWEST SUMMIT COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (SWSCOG) FOR ZETRON MAX DISPATCH EQUIPMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Norton will be invoiced for their portion of this cost, annually;
and

WHEREAS, this purchase agreement is a necessity as the gateway portion of the system has to go through and be operational by December 31, 2025, as other equipment will be on a new system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a lease to purchase an agreement with NCL Government Capital on behalf of SWSCOM to finance the acquisition of the following:

SECTION 2. That Council hereby authorizes the Director of Finance to execute a Lease Agreement on behalf of the City, together with such revisions and additions as are approved by the Mayor and Director of Law as being consistent with the objectives of this ordinance. The Mayor and other City officials are authorized to execute such other documents and do all other things as are necessary for, and incidental to, carrying out the requirements of this ordinance and the terms of the Agreement.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and that it concerns the efficient operation of the City to enter into contract in order to meet timliness, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall, therefore, be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
