

**ORDINANCE NO. 148-2025**

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION  
STREET DEPARTMENT**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$17,000.00 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE STREET OPERATING FUND TO THE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE BUDGET OF THE STREET OPERATING FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, These funds will be used to remove the former tank barn at the Service Garage on Brady Avenue; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the sum of Seventeen Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$17,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Street Operating Fund to the Operations and Maintenance Budget of the Street Operating Fund, to be used to remove the former tank barn at the Service Garage on Brady Avenue.

**SECTION 2.** That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

**SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of it’s committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to remove this building in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after it’s passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
