## **ORDINANCE NO. 156-2025**

## TITLE: APPROPRIATION PARKS DEPARTMENT

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$9,927.87 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED LINE ITEM OF THE GENERAL FUND TO THE PARKS ADMINISTRATIVE CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE GENERAL FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, these monies were given to the Parks and Recreation Department for the insurance claim filed as a result of storm damage on May 18, 2025;

**WHEREAS**, these monies will be used to repair the fencing at Edgewood Park and the dugout at the Barberton Community Sports Complex.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the sum of Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Seven Dollars and Eighty-Seven Cents (\$9,927.87) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Line Item of the General Fund to the Parks Administrative Capital Budget of the General Fund.

**SECTION 2.** That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

**SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of it's committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to complete the repairs as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
