**TITLE: APPLICATION SUPPORT
AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY
(AMATS) GRANT FUNDING**

A ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON SUPPORTING APPLICATIONS TO THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (AMATS) FOR CONSIDERATION FOR GRANT FUNDING FOR FUTURE ROAD RESURFACING PROJECTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the roads to be considered for future resurfacing projects are as follows:

1. Fifth Street NE-Lockwood Road to Baird Avenue
2. Robinson Avenue-Van Buren Avenue to State Street
3. Eighth Street-Wooster Road West to West Hopocan Avenue
4. Wooster Road West-Johnson Road to 31st Street SW
5. Sixth Street-Wooster Road West to West Hopocan Avenue
6. Hudson Run-Wooster Road West to 21st Street SW

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Barberton supports applications to the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) for consideration for grant funding for future road resurfacing projects.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to continue the process in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
