**TITLE: AMEND BARBERTON CODIFIED ORDINANCE
CHAPTER 1060: REFUSE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL
SECTION 1060.02 (B)(1)(A) METHOD OF COLLECTION**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BARBERTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES CHAPTER 1060: REFUSE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL” TO REFLECT A CHANGE IN WORDING FOR SECTION 1060.02(B)(1)(A) “ALLOWABLE WEEKLY PICKUPS”, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Sections, 1060.02 (B)(1)(A) “Allowable Weekly Pickups” and “Refuse Recyclable Collection and Disposal Program”(BCO Chapter 1060) shall be amended to reflect a change in wording, by showing the following additions in **bold** print and deletions with ~~striketrough~~.

1060.02 Allowable Weekly Pickups.

(B) *Allowable weekly pickups.*

(1) (a) Allowable items for weekly pickups (maximum two cubic yards volume per week outside of the provided 95-gallon refuse cart) or any special citywide pickup programs may include:

1. Bags (20 or 30 gallons - securely tied);
2. Bathroom fixtures (residential);
3. Bookcases (no pieces larger than four feet by four feet by four inches, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
4. Car seats;
5. Carpet (securely tied in rolls no longer than four feet, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
6. Dog houses, dismantled (no pieces larger than four feet by four feet by four inches, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
7. Fencing (rolled and tied, not over four feet in length, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
8. Firewood storage boxes, dismantled (not over four feet long);
9. Furnaces (residential, cut into four-foot lengths, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
10. Furniture (~~mattresses and upholstered furniture containing bed bugs must be wrapped in plastic~~ **All mattresses and upholstered furniture shall be wrapped in plastic.**);
11. Grass (if bagged and securely tied);
12. House doors (residential, cut into four-foot lengths, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
13. Household appliances: washers, dryers, stoves and the like (no items with Freon and/or refrigeration compressors);

14. Mufflers (cut into four-foot lengths);
15. Pallets (no longer than four feet, dismantled and tied in bundles, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
16. Picnic tables, dismantled (no pieces larger than four feet by four feet by four inches, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
17. Private waste containers (33 gallons or less, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
18. Remodeling debris (homeowner generated only - no pieces larger than four feet by four feet by four inches - nails removed, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
19. Spouting (cut into four-foot lengths, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
20. Storm doors (residential);
21. Storm windows (residential);
22. Swing sets, dismantled (no pieces larger than four feet by four feet by four inches, must weigh less than 60 pounds);
23. Tail pipes;
24. Tree trimmings, brush or hedge trimmings (if tied in bundles no longer than four feet);
25. TV antenna, dismantled;
26. Water heaters (residential);
27. Window boxes or planters (not over four feet long, must weigh less than 60 pounds); and
28. Wood (no larger than four feet by four feet by four inches, with no exposed nails, tied in bundles).

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, to ensure the changes take place at the time of the new contract, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
